Dear Mr Rehemaa,

We have analysed the notification you have provided to the EDPS for prior-checking under Article 27(2)(a) of Regulation 45/2001 ("the Regulation") on the processing of health data at the Body of European Regulators for Electronic Communications ("BEREC") in the light of the EDPS Guidelines on health data at workplace ("the EDPS Guidelines").

The EDPS is satisfied that both the notification and privacy statement provide thorough information about the data protection principles and safeguards in the context of pre-recruitment and annual check-ups, as well as the processing of sick leave certificates. The information provided to the EDPS indicates that BEREC has put in place sufficient measures, in light of the EDPS Guidelines, to ensure that the processing operation is in conformity with the Regulation.

The EDPS has therefore decided to the close the case 2013-0388.
