Name: EDPS mobile app on the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

<u>Description</u>: EU Data Protection Reform is a cost-free mobile app developed by the European Data Protection Supervisor (EDPS). It allows to compare the latest texts proposed by the European Commission, European Parliament, Council of the European Union, for modernising data protection rules in Europe as well as the recommendations of the EDPS for the "trilogue" negotiations. The EU legislators aim to adopt a General Data Protection Regulation that will be directly applicable in all EU member states by the end of 2015.

The EDPS app does not collect any personal information from the user. The EDPS only use the device IP address to count anonymously how many people have used the app and will not use it in any other way.

Users of the EDPS mobile app.

The only data processed relating to individuals are the IP addresses of the devices of the EDPS mobile appusers .

"This app does not collect any of your personal information. We only use the IP address to count how many people have used the app and we will not use it in any other way.
