The head of unit signs the claim form. A photocopy of the claim is taken and the original documents are sent by registered mail to the insurance company.

The person in the ACI payments office of SCIC-B4 who deals with the claim files the copy in a locked archive room.

Photocopies of the claims are kept in a locked archive room.

The medical information concerning the type of illness/accident is not stored electronically in DG SCIC.

The dates of the incapacity to work are imported into GRIF (the ACI payments system) from a programme used by DG SCIC unit C2.
