The AGS-EDV database consists of records of persons who work in the radiation protection areas of the Institute for Transuranium Elements in Karlsruhe.

Each person must follow a compulsory radiation protection information session which is given by an official of the radioprotection group.

During this course the person has to provide some personal data which are collected on a paper form, on this form also appear different parameters which are given by the radioprotection officer.

In order to record each exposed person who works in a radioprotection area, we use the mentioned form. When it is completed it contains the following information:

- Name, surname, date of birth, nationality
- Name & address of the respective company
- Date of last medical clearance
- Types of dosimeters to be given
- Type of medical and incorporation analyses to be organised

8) Automated Processing operation(s):

A unique number is attributed to each person, this identification number will be used at the ITU according to §42, StrlSchV.

The database is set to detect persons who are exceeding predefined limits of doses, therefore reports with the names of persons are produced automatically in order to inform as quickly as possible and to maintain doses as low as possible.

Periodical reports are produced in order to inform responsible and authorised bodies in the different companies and supervisory authorities about the received doses.

9) Manual Processing operation(s):

All data are entered according to 17).

Any kind of report can be made manually after authorisation of access to the database, that is if necessary.

Besides this we produce the following reports every month:

- List of persons wearing dosimeters
- List of decreasing doses in order to identify the highest exposition
- Collective doses for the institute
- Production of statistical graphs showing how doses are received over a period of time
- Detailed reports on demand (exposed person, hierarchy or medical service)
