The performance evaluation will be sent to the FWC'r for comments by him and the experts to be provided within a period fixed in the notification not less than 14 days. The FWCr has the obligation to communicate to each expert the part containing her/his evaluation and collect her/his comments within a minimum period of 10 days from their notification. He will forward them to the Contracting authority within the period given to him for comments. If the Contracting Authority maintains his version, he notifies the FWC'r of his decision and records his assessment together with the comments received from the FWC'r and the experts in the FWC performance database. The FWC'r will inform the experts of such a decision. It is foreseen to have the following operations: the Commission services and evaluators of offers in competitive procedures will have access to the evaluation and comments of a given expert or a given framework contractor. A search can be made upon a name of a person or of a framework contractor and the system will give a list of the operations recorded for this person or contractor. The list of results will give access to a) the evaluation form filled in + to the comments of the concerned experts or/and firms + b) to the corresponding specific contract. Instructions will be given so that no decision affecting the subjects of the evaluations can be made on the sole basis of these records.

The processing is necessary in order to have a good financial management of public funds by checking past experience/results that the Commission had with experts contracted through the same contractual tool (FWC). Short term expertise which is recruited through the FWC presents high risks induced by the fact that it is usually external experts (not in house) and very volatile expertise (frequent unavailability at the beginning of implementation).

Indeed, the on line consultation of past assignments evaluations might avoid contracting inappropriate expertise when examining offers for future assignments and can help improving the quality of external aid credits management.
