Selection of experts pursuant to the ERA 'Call for experts to assist the work of the Working Parties/Task Forces/Groups of the European Railway Agency in the field of Railway Interoperability'.

4/ Purpose or purposes of the processing

The main purpose of personal data collection and processing is to select experts to assist the work of the Working Parties/Task Forces/Groups of the European Railway Agency in the field of railway interoperability. Furthermore, personal data of experts for reimbursement of expenses are also collected. The call for experts are sent by the Agency to all the concerned organisations in the field of interoperability as defined by the Agency regulation. The assesement is done on the basis of the needs of each working group in terms of expertise available in the railway organisations. For the assessment the Agency is using as guide the terms of reference established for each working group and the work which has to be performed by the working group as well as the requirements on exterised for the experts to be nominated by the sector. The selection is carried out by the unit members responsible for the management of the working groups.

5/ Description of the category or categories of data subjects

Proposed experts by the represenative bodiesin the railway identified in the Agency Regulation.

Data to identify and contact the applicant: family name, given name, date of birth, gender, nationality, private postal address, e-mail address, fax and telephone number. Data relevant to demonstrate, in the framework of the selection procedure, that the applicant fulfills the profile advertised in the vacancy notice: CV in European format and application form. Additional Data in case an appointment letter is offered: any document verifying the candidate's technical and professional competence (diplomas, certificates of previous work experience) upon request, ID/passport number and bank account details for reimbursement of expenses.

The information is given through a personal data protection statement/privacy statement is published with the call and it is attached to this notification.

11/ Legal basis and lawfulness of the processing operation
Article 3(4) of Regulation No (EC) 881/2004 establishing a European Railway Agency as amended by Regulation No (EC) 1335/2008 offers the possibility to the European Railway Agency to “if necessary, add to the working parties independent expert recognised as competent in the field concerned”.
12/ The recipients or categories of recipient to whom the data might be disclosed
Agency staff: the data provided by the candidates are accessible by the secretariat, the Data Protection Coordinator (DPC), the project officer responsible for organization of the selection panel, the members of the selection committees, the Head of Unit (HoU) as appointing authority and the project officers leading working parties, in the Interoperability Unit. Other EU institutions staff: any of the supervisory instances of ERA i.e. European Court of Auditors, Internal Audit Service, and in case of controversy, Ombudsman, etc. may have access to this data upon request.
