When a Member receives a negative recommendation she/he must comply with the recommendation within 30 working days.

The President is responsible for ensuring that the negative recommendation is implemented.

If the concerned Member does not agree with the negative recommendation she/he can within 15 working days write to the President.

The President submits the matter without delay to the Court which shall take a decision within 15 working days.

When a Member has not complied with a negative recommendation within the deadline and without having informed the President of its disagreement the President will submit the matter to the Court. The Court shall take a decision within 15 working days.

When the Court comes to a decision that the negative recommendation is maintained the President shall be responsible for ensuring the decision is implemented.

To this end the concerned Member shall have 30 workings days to comply with the decision.

When the Members does not comply after that deadline the President (or the Member replacing him) shall submit the matter to the Court which shall decide if the Court of Justice will be asked to deprive the Member concerned of his office.
