4/ PURPOSE OR PURPOSES OF THE PROCESSING

According to current Rules of Procedure of the Em and the Operating Rules of the AAC, the Committee shall provide non-binding opinions on the suitability of the candidates proposed by Member States as members of the Management Committee (MC) of the European Investment Bank (Em).

As soon as a Member State presents a candidate to be proposed for appointment, the Secretary General of the Bank shall send that proposal to the Chairman of the AAC.

The AAC shall assess whether the candidate satisfies the criteria set out in the Rules of Procedure of the Bank.

In the context of the assessment, the AAC may request additional information and/or documents from the Member State. It may also ask that a confidential hearing be held with the candidate.

The opinion of the AAC on the candidate will consist in either a non-objection or a statement of reservation. In the latter case, reasons should be provided with the opinion.

The AAC will provide its opinion to the nominating Member State on a bilateral and confidential basis as well as to the candidate.

Should the Member State wish to proceed to propose its candidate after receipt of the Committee's opinion, that opinion must be included with the proposal. If the Committee has not provided its opinion within 60 days from the request, the Member State may propose its candidate without the opinion of the Committee.

Appointments to the Management Committee of the EIB are made by the Board of Governors on a proposal from the Board of Directors in accordance with the following process: a) the proposal from the nominating Member State (including the Committee's opinion) is transmitted to the Board of Directors upon its receipt by the EIB's Secretary General; ii) once approved by the Board of Directors, the EIB's Secretary General sends the proposal for the appointment (including the Committee's opinion) to the Board of Governors for approval.

Persons whose names will be proposed by the EU Member States - accordingly to the EIB applicable rules — to be nominated for the EIB Management Committee.

Under Article 2(2) of the AAC Operating Rules, assessment of the candidate's "high integrity and high reputation" as well as "his or her ability to ensure the sound and prudent management of the Bank".

Account shall be taken inter alia "of factors such as convictions or pending prosecutions of a criminal offence...";

Under Article 2(3) of the AAC Operating Rules, the AAC considers the candidates theoretical and practical experience as well as "skills and knowledge acquired and demonstrated by the professional conduct of the candidate". It further looks at "the candidate's ability to perform his or her duties independently".

An "information form" to be completed in agreement with the candidate is provided to the nominating Member State, together with a curriculum vitae of the candidate. This form gathers information on the candidate personal identification details, theoretical and practical experience of the candidate (incl. professional experience, education, and other relevant trainings), and information about the integrity of the candidate (incl. basic general information on criminal antecedents, financial antecedents, conduct, and financial holding and business interests and obligations).

By virtue of Article 8(3) of the Operating Rules of the AAC, the Committee is also authorised to ask for and use any information it deems relevant for the proper performance of its duties.

71 INFORMATION TO BE GIVEN TO DATA SUBJECTS

The candidate will be informed on the "Information form" that his their personal data will be processed by the AAC, under the terms of the regulation 4512001 — as amended from time to time — for what purposes and what kind of data, and that they will have the right to access, to modify, to block and to erase their data, as well of lodging a complaint to the European Data Protection Supervisor.

PROCEDURES TO GRANT RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS

(Rights of access, to rectify, to block, to erase, to object)

Under request, the AAC Secretary will provide access for data subjects to their processed data. Data subjects have the right to rectify inaccuracies, and in certain conditions duly justified, to block and to erase it (article 13, 14, 15 and 16 of Regulation 4512001).
