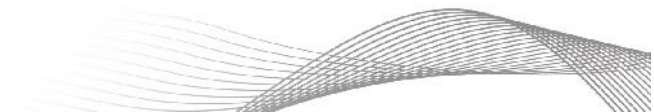


EDPS record of processing activity

9.	Time limit for keeping the data	Data will be stored by the EDPS in electronic and paper files for a maximum of ten years.
10.	Recipients of the data	The requests are handled internally on a need to know basis. Data might be transferred to other EU institutions and bodies or to any third parties only when necessary to ensure appropriate reply to the request for information advice.
