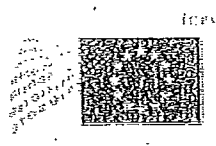
The EDPS acknowledges receipt of FRA's request for revision of the EDPS Decision of 25 June 2015 in the complaint [redacted] (case 2014-0144).


In a letter of 7 December 2015, FRA has provided the EDPS with relevant information on the
