We are writing to you following your email of 11 December 2019 regarding case 2018-0688. Thank you for providing in a timely manner the EDPS with the requested follow-up information.

We examined all the documentation sent by you and we believe that EMA addressed all the EDPS recommendations by 1) adopting rules regarding the processing of personal data to prevent the circumvention of the access to documents queuing system; as well as 2) informing data subjects about those rules in the data protection notice/privacy statement.
