The LIBE Secretariat is contacting you, on behalf of Mr Juan Fernando Lopez Aguilar, Chair of the Committee on Civil Liberties, Justice and Home Affairs of the European Parliament (LIBE Committee) to invite the EDPB or the EDPS to take part in an **exchange of views** with the Members of the LIBE Committee on the Pegasus spyware on **Monday 29 November 2021**.

Following the revelations made about the Pegasus spyware, Members of the LIBE Committee would like to hear from you about your assessment on the issues raised by such program and its consequence for fundamental rights, and particularly its impact on privacy. This would be highly relevant to the LIBE Members, in their continuous work on fundamental rights.

The Chair of LIBE would welcome if the EDPS or the EDPB could be available for this Exchange of Views with the LIBE Members, on Monday 29 November 2021 during an 1h exchange of views to be organised between **15:45-16:45**.

To cover all the elements of this case, the LIBE Committee has also invited two other speakers to this exchange of views with LIBE Members: a representative of the Forbidden Stories consortium and a technical expert from Amnesty International's security lab. A timeslot of 7min is foreseen per speaker to present his/her statement/analysis, followed by Q&A session with the Members.

Should you accept this invitation, further information as to the details for remote connection, timeslot and overall organisation of the exchange of views will be provided to you. Participation will be in hybrid mode (physical presence and remote participation regimes are currently in place in the European Parliament).
